

2024 Scholarship Application

PURPOSE

The purpose of the Frontier Foundation scholarship program is to award scholarships to Frontier Credit Union members to aid them in their pursuit of higher education. Scholarships are a single monetary reward to be applied to the cost of tuition, books, and/or lab fees (if applicable).

AVAILABLE SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

- 1 (one) \$2000 Frontier Foundation Grand Prize Scholarship
- 9 (nine) \$1000 Frontier Foundation Scholarships
- 1 (one) \$1000 Arlene Walker Scholarship

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a member of Frontier Credit Union with an account in your name.
- Must be a graduating high school senior and plan to attend an accredited college, university or technical school in the United States as a full-time student. (Funds can be held if student is planning a gap year or service opportunity before enrolling in college.)
- Must provide verification of acceptance to school before scholarship funds are disbursed.
- Must have a GPA of 3.0 or greater.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- All required portions of the application must be completed and returned by March 18th, 2024.
- A supporting essay must accompany each scholarship application.
- A supporting letter of recommendation must accompany each scholarship application.
- A current transcript with GPA must accompany each scholarship application.

ESSAY REQUIREMENTS

- Essay must be no less than one page and no longer than two pages in length on the given topic.
- Essay must be typed using Times New Roman 12-point font, double-spaced, and have margins of 1" on the top and bottom and left and right.
- Applicant's full name must appear at the top of each page of the essay.
- Essay will be judged based on content, proper use of grammar, spelling and punctuation.

ESSAY TOPIC

How do you aspire to contribute to improving your community, Idaho or the world? How will your continued education help prepare you to achieve these goals?

BASIS OF SELECTION

Winners will be judged and selected based on the following criteria:

- GPA
- Student Involvement / Work Experience
- Volunteer Work / Community Involvement
- Essay
- · Letter of Recommendation
